If you are using more than one Boolean operative in your search, you must identify which action should be first with parenthesis. Ex: (education and literacy) not research. You may also search by keyword or exact keyword phrase, by recipient, by category, by location, by type of funder, by GrantWatch ID #, and by deadline. You may include ongoing

grants without deadlines and past due grants. Using less filters will achieve greater results.
